Is Your Trailer Road Ready?

Here's a handy checklist to help you get your trailer ready for a safe season ahead.

1) Check trailer lights

- a) Confirm that lights work
- b) Check trailer wiring connection to vehicle
 - Clean out corrosion
 - Make sure connectors fit snugly

2) Check trailer tires

- a) Verify proper inflation (including spare)
- b) Check for cracks and dry rot

3) Check hubs

- a) Check grease in hubs
- b) Check bearings
- c) If equipped with electric brakes, check breakaway battery and breakaway switch

4) Check trailer coupler for wear and functional latch

5) Check safety chains for wear

6) Check other components such as winches, jacks, rollers, bunks, ramps and leaf springs
